What Pharmacy Technicians Do

Pharmacy technicians help pharmacists dispense prescription medication to customers or health professionals; working in a variety of pharmacy settings, including retail pharmacies and hospitals.

Pharmacy Technicians typically do the following:

- Take from customers or health professionals the information needed to fill a prescription
- Count tablets and measure amounts of other medication for prescriptions
- Compound or mix medications, package and label prescriptions
- Accept payment for prescriptions and process insurance claims, do routine pharmacy tasks, such as answering
 phone calls from customers. Pharmacy technicians work under the supervision of pharmacists, who must review
 all prescriptions before they are given to patients. If a customer's question is about the medication or health
 matters, the pharmacy technician arranges for the customer to speak with the pharmacist.

Pharmacy technicians working in hospitals and other medical facilities prepare a greater variety of medications, such as intravenous medications.
