Steps to Apply for a Federal Direct Loan at CAJ FAFSA 2025-2026

- Have a high school diploma or GED.
- You must be a U.S. Citizen/National, permanent resident, or eligible noncitizen
- Complete the FAFSA and receive a valid SAR
- Currently be enrolled in eligible programs
- Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress
- Have completed all requirements including verification if required
- Not be in default on a student loan or owe a refund on state or federal education grant
- You cannot receive loans at two institutions at the same time

Student creates a <u>FSA ID Account</u> first – then fill out the FAFSA application. You can also go to <u>www.studentaid.gov</u> on the internet.

- **Step 1:** Complete the FAFSA 2025-2026 online at <u>FAFSA Application</u> CAJ School Code: 009509
- Step 2: Complete Annual Student Loan Acknowledgment online at Loan Acknowledgment
 Look for "Sacramento City Unified School District."

 (Please print out a copy of the confirmation for the Financial Aid Office)
- **Step 3:** Complete Loan Entrance Counseling online at Entrance Counseling You will be asked to notify your school. Look for "Sacramento City Unified School District."

 (Please print out a copy of Entrance Counseling for the Financial Aid Office)
- **Step 4:** Complete a Master Promissory Note (MPN) online at <u>Master Promissory Note</u> (*Please print copies of pages 1-3 of the promissory note for the Financial Aid Office.*)
- **Step 5:** Complete the Federal Stafford Loan Request Form (in-person at CAJ)
- **Step 6:** Complete the Identity and Statement of Educational Purpose Form (in-person at CAJ)

Step 7: Verification Process: After 3-5 days from submitting the FAFSA application, please come **IN PERSON** to the CAJ Financial Aid Office and bring your physical Photo ID, copies of your Social Security Card, H.S. Diploma/Equivalency, assessment test score, all financial aid packet paperwork, and all tax transcripts/untaxed incomes for 2023. You will fill out the forms from Steps 5 and 6 at this time and obtain your payment voucher for program enrollment.

Step 8: Take the financial aid voucher to the CAJ office and enroll in the CAJ career training program qualified for.
